INTRODUCTION

Querétaro, is one of 31 states that, with the Federal District, comprise the 32 Federal Entities of Mexico. It is divided into 18 municipalities. Its capital city is Santiago de Queretaro.

It is located in North Center of Mexico, in a region known as Bajío. It is bordered by the states of San Luis Potosí to the north, Guanajuato to the west, Hidalgo to the east, México to the southeast and Michoacán to the southwest.

Nowadays this city is one of the most representatives of the country due to geographical location and its closeness with typical and touristic cities and towns.

It is located about 200 kilometers away from Mexico City.

General Information



Most of the time between March, April, May and June, the temperature ranges from 15°C to 35°C. In July, August and September the temperature ranges from 10°C to 30°C, with rain in the evenings but not every day. Starting in October, November and December the temperature drops in the morning about 4°C and in the afternoon could reach 28°C. January and February are the coldest months of the year and could be 2°C to 18°C or 23°C afternoon.



Points of Interest at Querétaro



Museo de la Zacatecana

This museum preserves works of decorative art as well as sculpture and painting of Mexico, Europe and Orient from the XVII to XX centuries..



Museo de Arte Querétaro

Museo Regional de Querétaro

The purpose of Queretaro Regional Museum is to preserve and display the artistic and historical wealth of the country and particularly the state of Queretaro, currently it has six permanent exhibition halls divided into five themes:

Pre-Hispanic Queretaro, Queretaro Indian peoples, Site hall, colonial Queretaro, Queretaro in Mexican history.



Centro Académico Cultural UNAM

The Academic Cultural Center of the UNAM Campus Juriquilla, opening in November 2006, turning 10 years of continuous activity, focused on promoting on the society it's fundamental principles, such as research, knowledge and cultural promotion. Its commitment and events are intended to awaken and promote interest in science, technology, culture and art..







Teatro del Seguro Social

The theater was built in 1957 inaugurated on November 6, 1964, under the design of architect Alejandro Prieto. The first presentation was given by J. Guadalupe Ramirez Alvarez with a show of works by Xavier Villaurrutia. It presents theater, opera, music, dance, children's shows, festivals, conferences and assemblies.



Auditorio Esperanza Cabrera

The auditorium is located within the School of Music at the Faculty of Fine Arts. In the space activities of theater, music, dance, variety shows, conferences, assemblies and classroom they are made.



Auditorio Josefa Ortiz de Domínguez

Plays and various events are presented.



Teatro de la República

It was originally called Gran Teatro de Iturbide, later Iturbide Theatre, and from 1922 Theater of the Republic. Here first she sang the National Anthem.

Peña de Bernal

With 350 meters, 4,000,000 tons and 10,000,000 years old, Peña de Bernal is the third largest monolith in the world after the Rock of Gibraltar, in Spain, and Sugar Loaf, Brazil.

It is possible to climb to the top of this rock with the right equipment and a professional guide. The hiking is rewarded with a unique perspective on the vast semi desert of Queretaro. At night, one can see from the esplanade this rock in the beam of a light show that is combined with a dancing fountain, elegantly arranged.




